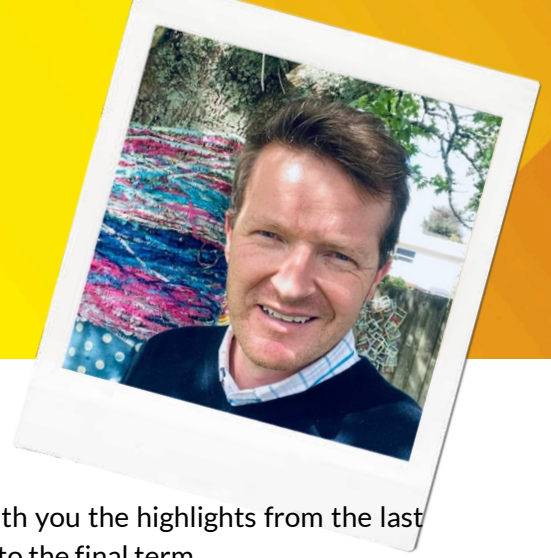

HEALTH AND SAFETY UPDATE - CARPARK CROSSING

Our carpark in the afternoon can be a very busy place. Our tamariki safety is number 1. HEALTH AND SAFETY UPDATE - SMOKE / VAPE FREE SCHOOL

This is a reminder to our community that our school is a smoke and vape free zone. That is for all people that enter the school grounds. If students are caught with a vape on school grounds we will be making contact with families to discuss the next steps. It is something we take very seriously, so please whānau, be mindful of what your children bring to school each day.



TERMS 1 AND 4 - DON BUCK SCHOOL HATS

Please make sure that your child has a Don Buck School hat during term 1 and 4. Due to our sun safety policy we require all tamariki to have a Don Buck School uniform hat to ensure they're staying safe during these hot summer months.

You can purchase these hats from the office or online for \$16.50.

If your child is not wearing a school hat we will be asking them to stay inside or in our designated shade spot during all break times.

We are also encouraging tamariki to leave these at school each day so they have them at school. They do not need to be wearing them home.





REMINDER - DBS MOBILE PHONE POLICY

As we come into Term 3 this is just a reminder to our community that our school is following the Government's mobile phone policy very closely and have developed clear process around these in school.

Unless required by whānau for safety reasons, no mobile phones will be allowed on our school sites by students. Any phones required by whānau will be collected and kept safe at the office.
